Body of Manuscript

Manuscript must be prepared on standard A4 size paper setting ranging between 2500 to 3000 words. It must be prepared on a 1.15 spacing and single column with 1-inch margin set for top, bottom, left and right. It should be typed in 11-point Times New Roman font with page numbers at the bottom centre of every page.

Heading

All section headings should be in 14-point Times New Roman font. These must be bold faced, aligned left and fully capitalized. Leave a blank line before each heading.

Figures & Tables

These must be simple, centered and numbered, with the titles of the tables above the tables and title of the figures below the figures. Sources of tables/figures should be mentioned below them.

Citation & References

References within the text and at the end of the paper should be in the style prescribed in the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (APA), 6th edition.

Awards

"Best Paper Award" will be presented in the valedictory ceremony of the conference. The award will be decided by a specially designated committee of experts.
